Aloha Vendors! Just over a week before the 52nd Wiki Wiki show on the 30th! This is a special mid-renovation show to be held in the Blaisdell Exhibition Hall.

Show setup starts at 8am. Before we open, all tables must be checked and adjusted for accurate spacing and labeling, coin cases must be unloaded and distributed, and the show security team must be present and in place before the setup can begin.

Face masks are optional.

Wear them if you want. They're not required in this show.

Only Vintage

Please make sure to bring only vintage items (20 years & older) to the show. Do not sell or buy anything until 10am when the early birds come in. We advertise a Vintage sale with no pre-sales. The public really appreciates a show that has not been pre-picked.

No Pre-sales

Please remember that no presales are allowed before 10am. Also, no saving or reserving items are allowed.

Prior to 10am, no one is supposed to be walking around looking at other vendor's things. Vendors who are seen wandering into other vendors' tables may not be invited back to future shows.

Setup, Takedown, & Parking

There are 2 loading doors into the Hall. One is from the vendor's loading lot in back of the ExHall (#1) and the other is opposite the parking building (#2, see map below). **Remember to pick up your badges at door #1 first.** Bring your partner's IDs to pick up their badges.

For door #1, please park temporarily in the vendor's loading lot and enter the hall through the glass doors.

If your entry is through door #2, please park in the parking building then enter through the glass doors on the east concourse.

Please do not park in the Box Office parking lot or the Galleria's parking loop on Ward Avenue. Your car will be towed.

While in the vendor's loading lot, please move your cars as soon as you are done unloading so that other vendors can unload. We will have a few large carts for vendors to use but they run out pretty fast. Get on our waiting list if none are available.

Setup Times- 8am-11am. Badges given out at 7:30am.

Unescorted use of all wagons and carts will end at 10am (early entry). After 10am, all carts must be escorted by us. Please let us know and we will escort your cart through the hall (Blaisdell rules). You can start selling to the Early Entry people at 10am or you can continue to set up until the show officially opens at 11am.

Storage Behind Your TableSpace

You may leave empty boxes behind the curtains/barriers. For vendors in the middle of the hall, you may use the space between the back of your booth and the blue tape line. This space is for storage only. No customers allowed in this special storage area.

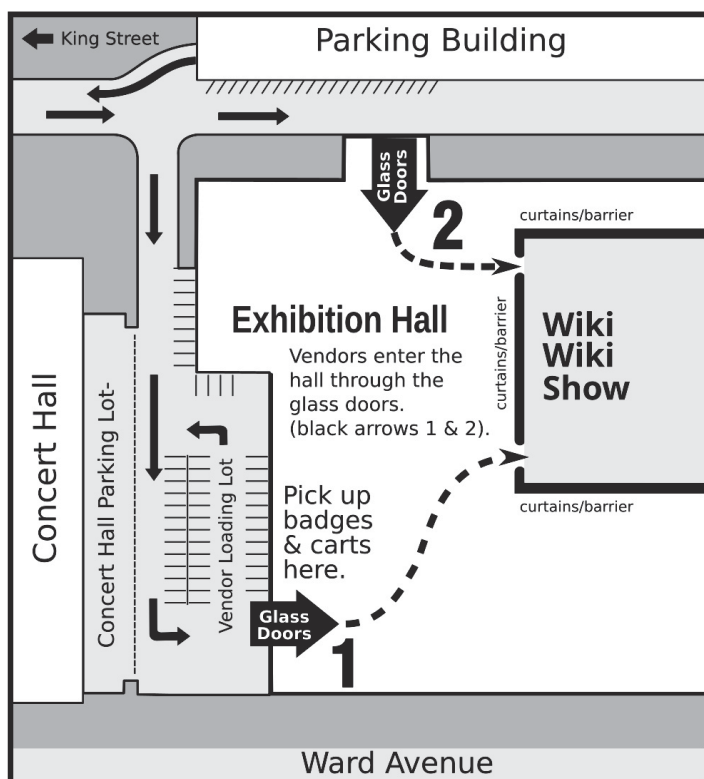

Lunch

There will be a couple of food vendors inside the Ex Hall.

Other food sources nearby are **Jack in the Box** and **HI One Sushi** on the 2 corners of Ward Ave. and Kapiolani Blvd. There's also **Mr. Tea Cafe**, a coffee/tea shop (opens at noon) next door to the sushi shop.



General Excise Tax License

Just a reminder to all vendors to bring your State General Excise Tax License and receipt books to the show. I'm sure all of you know this and abide by the state's tax laws.

ATM Machine

There is an ATM machines near the main entrance inside the Ex Hall. In addition, there are 2 machines outside next to the Box Office. Customers may re-enter the show with a hand stamp. Just ask the usher before leaving the room.

Loading Badges and Badge Changes

If you need assistance with heavy items or have a physical disability, you can request a **LOADING BADGE** for a friend to help you in advance of the show. Loading badges are for active loading only. Once done loading, your helper must leave.

All requests for new badges or badge changes done at the show will cost \$10.00 each if approved; approval is not guaranteed. This applies to ANY & ALL badges. No loading badges made on show date. If you do not want to incur this cost, please call/send/email your badge changes **BEFORE** Sunday. Changes made before Sunday are free.

Tabletop Coin Case Rentals

Table top coin case rental fee is \$22 each for the run of the show. Case dimensions are 34" X 24" X 3". Rentals are courtesy of the Hawaii State Numismatic Association. These Allstate aluminum cases come with lock and key. Lost keys incur a \$5 replacement fee.

To order coin cases call or email us to reserve a case. You can pay HSNA at the show.

No Early Takedown

The show ends at 4:30pm and everyone agreed to stay until then. Please do not leave the show or empty your tables before 4:30.

Show Take Down Times

4:30pm-7pm. Everything must be out of the hall by 7pm on Sunday. Make sure your helpers are wearing their badges.

Parking rates

Street parking is **FREE** on Sunday. However, if you can't find street parking, for \$10.00 you can purchase an Exhibitor's parking pass as you enter the Blaisdell parking lot. You have to ask for it. This pass allows you unlimited re-entry to the parking lot for that day only. The regular parking fee(no re-entry) is \$8.00 per day.

If you have any collector related events coming up please have some flyers made and leave them on our flyer table outside.
